In the project 3N dealt on one side with numerous questions and discussions and individual counselling about biofuels, on the other side 3N active approach people who could be interested in

this topic and ask them if 3N could help them. In this case the biofuel players in the region will be cross linked.

Most information is given about using and producing PPO, Biogas as fuel and Ethanol. Because of the change in the German tax system of biofuels (Biodiesel and PPO), the demand for this information is greatly reduced. Much increased is the demand for information about biogas (biogas cleaning and pressuring) and gas filling stations, as well an increasing demand for information about the sustainable production of biofuels.

Relevant information for various stakeholders were offered by info materials, brochures, but also by workshops, presentations and by organization of study tours to biofuel plants.

The 3N Information Centre is also a part of the German biofuel portal (<http://www.biokraftstoff-portal.de>) and works in close connection with these German-wide biofuel experts. The biofuel experts of the institute can answer special questions about biofuel (e.g. technical developments and procedures).

What kind of services they offer

The front office is located at IBMER premises in Poznan and is supported with Polish website of BioMotion project (www.biomotion.pl). The head of BIC is Assist. Prof. Anna Grzybek, renewable energy expert, who works at IBMER office in Warsaw.

Information is the obtained through the web service. IBMER keep track of it, update and modify its content, according to the latest inquiries and the progress of BioMotion project. Next to the description of project you can find there some information concerning the requirements of Polish law in the area of biofuels. In general, interested people have the possibility to find out about different types of biofuels and the progress of their development.

People engaged in BioMotion project are in permanent contact with authorities of Poviastarost in Gniezno and Mashall Office of Wielkopolska Region, represented by Department of Agriculture, responsible in the province for renewable energy coming from agriculture sector in general. The result of cooperation was meetings and conferences where there were possibilities to inform audiences consisting of pupils and farmers, about law regulations and BioMotion project principles.

In reaction to the situation, where there is no significant feedback from the potential beneficiaries, IBMER decided to focus on the young generation of future agricultural labour markets, i.e. agricultural technical schools in order to initiate eco-friendly behaviour and positive attitude towards biofuels among the future farmers. Thus, the Polish partner decided to organize educational workshops and trips for pupils and students. They are always supported with presentations concerning the substance. Visitors have the possibility to familiarize with regulations for biofuel production in Poland and the methods and solutions of biofuel production in farm conditions.

There were only few contacts concerning the conditions for biodiesel production from Polish farmer’s side. The reasons of that situation are: legal condition and hard tax procedures concerning fuels for propulsion that don’t encourage farmers to invest in equipment for biofuel production. There were no inquires from biofuel filling station owners, car producers and car dealers.

What kind of services they offer

The French regulations on the use of biofuel are very rigorous. Thus, most information is given about the rules and the tax systems of biofuels for consumers.

Information spent depends of the public: because of the French system, the farmers are only able to use PPO in their trucks. We inform them about producing, cleaning and using PPO for their own consumption.

Cars dealers, public and private consumers are more interested in using bioethanol and biodiesel. We mainly inform them about the way to use those biofuels (E85, E10, B30...) and the sustainability of those biofuels (increase awareness of this issue).

We don't have demand about biogas yet because this system doesn't really exist in France (only one filling station for buses, no cars). There are less than 20 biogas plants in France!
